

Prairie Aviation Museum offers a number of volunteer opportunities to support the museum's mission "To educate, entertain, and inspire through collecting, preserving, and displaying aircraft, artifacts, and memorabilia about aviation and space."

Examples of Prairie Aviation Museum volunteer opportunities are:

- Be a museum host during the open hours of the museum. Host training is required for this position. A host must be comfortable working as a solo individual.
- Be a museum host for special tours Host training and background check is required for this position.
- Be a museum host for Open Cockpit Day events.

Host training is required for this position.

Hosts are assigned to specific posts to interact with guests. Background training for the post is required with information provided by the museum.

Be a museum work team member for projects with aircraft, building and grounds Must be able to work successfully with other team members. Skills possessed will be helpful to maximize team productivity. Many projects are labor intensive requiring good physical condition.

Be a museum representative for off-site exhibitions and activities Representatives should have good informational background about the museum displays, programs, and objectives. Activities may have varied hours of operation.

Become a museum display developer and presenter

A display developer and presenter should have graphic design and display abilities. Organizational skills and interest in high quality display are required.

Be a museum technician supporting promotional materials, web postings, and social media postings

Technician should have skills in web design, social media posting, and creating quality public promotional materials. A variety of promotional materials will require the technician to select the most effective method for distribution.

Volunteers may be selected by museum leadership to serve specific roles for the museum based upon their individual skills or training.

Volunteers will be given a museum logo shirt and name tag to be worn when operating with a museum activity helping to identify affiliation with the museum.
